October is going to be a busy month at Christ the King. We kick things off with our annual Stewardship Weekend. This is a time in the life of the parish when we remember that the gifts we have are meant to be shared for the good of the community. When we make "giving" a priority, the parish flourishes. I am grateful to all of our parishioners who continue to give generously of their time, talent, and treasure. Thank you for being good stewards of the blessings God has given you.

The Catholic Church celebrates October as Respect Life Month. This year's theme given by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops is "Each of Us is a Masterpiece of God's Creation." For four weeks we contemplate the beauty of each human being made in the image and likeness of God. We would be horrified if, for example, Leonardo di Vinci's Mona Lisa were to be destroyed. Yet, each person is worth so much more than that masterpiece. We have a responsibility to do our part to protect human life, from womb to tomb. This is a small way in which we can build up a pro-life culture in our city.
