October is going to be a busy month at Christ the King. We kick things off with our annual Stewardship Weekend. This is a time in the life of the parish when we remember that the gifts we have are meant to be shared for the good of the community. When we make "giving" a priority, the parish flourishes. The Catholic Church celebrates October as Respect Life Month. This year's theme given by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops is "Each of Us is a Masterpiece of God's Creation."
