From the Pastor's Desk

We are in the midst of the Church's observation of National Marriage Week (Feb. 7-14), and this weekend we celebrate World Marriage Sunday. We take this opportunity to reflect upon the gift of married love and to support engaged and married couples within the Church. We believe that marriage is an exquisite blessing God has bestowed upon the human race. The exclusive and lifelong bond between husband and wife provides a stable home for children, as well as a greater financial, emotional, and spiritual foundation for a family. Marriage is indeed the institution that underpins the family and is thereby an essential aspect of every society. All this begs the question: Where would we be without marriage? The answer is frightening to consider. So we pray this weekend for married couples and for young men and women who will be married in the months ahead. May they never take for granted their vocation to marriage or forget its importance in the life of the Church and the world.

It turns out that February 8 is also the annual day of prayer and awareness against human trafficking. February 8 was chosen because it is the Feast of St. Josephine Bakhita, who was kidnapped as a child and sold into slavery in Sudan and Italy. Upon being set free, she became a religious sister and dedicated her life to comforting the poor and suffering. This heroic woman gives us a shining example of perseverance, hope, forgiveness, and holiness. Together with St. Josephine Bakhita, let pray for the tens of millions of slaves in the world today and do our part to eliminate this ongoing atrocity.
