From the Pastor's Desk

Our former maintenance man, Chris Drake, worked at Christ the King for more than twenty years. His commitment to our community and his vast experience made him a tremendous asset to our church. Upon retiring, Chris left a void that will be difficult to fill. Fortunately, the man chosen as his replacement is doing a great job thus far. Filling Chris' shoes is Olandino de la Cruz. Olandino is originally from the Dominican Republic but has been in the United States since 2000. Along with his wife, three daughters, and granddaughter, Olandino has been a member of Christ the King for approximately ten years. If you see him in the church in the days ahead, please introduce yourself and congratulate him on his new position.

Our next special collection will take place at the end of the month. It will be for the Holy Father, a collection commonly known as Peter's Pence. This collection, sponsored by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, provides Pope Francis with the financial means to tend to those who are suffering as a result of war, natural disaster, or disease. Our contribution to Peter's Pence allows us to stand in solidarity with the human family as the pope, on behalf of the Catholic Church, alleviates the direst needs of our brothers and sisters throughout the world. Last year the Catholic Church in the United States generously donated \$190 million for this fund.

Again, this special collection is not until June 28-29. But I wanted everyone to be aware of a change we are making in the life of our parish. If you would like to contribute to this special collection or any other special collection in the future, you will have two options. You can either use the designated envelope you receive in your packet of envelopes in the mail, or you can write "Special Collection" in the memo line on a check. Simply place the designated envelope or your check in the regular collection. *We will no longer pass the basket for special collections after communion.*

If there are any questions about this new procedure for special collections, please let me know. I will do my best to answer your concerns. My hope is that everyone will be able to note the upcoming special collections in the bulletin and donate to those funds as they are able.
