From the Pastor's Desk

In case you have not noticed, our two restrooms have been remodeled recently. New tile, sinks, and changing stations were installed – updates that were very badly needed. I am grateful to a family from our parish who donated funds to cover the cost of the renovated restroom in the cry room. The cost of the other bathroom renovation was covered by funds raised from the Bishop's Annual Appeal. Every dollar donated above and beyond our diocesan goal each year helps pay for capital improvement projects. Since we have gone over our goal for the past several years, we have funds to do things like remodel bathrooms. So, thank you to everyone who contributes to the Bishop's Annual Appeal!

The next big capital improvement project at Christ the King will be the installation of LED light fixtures in the church. This will take place within the next few months. We are able to afford this worthwhile project because of 1) funds raised from the Bishop's Annual Appeal and 2) a \$20,000 grant we have received from the Catholic Foundation. The Catholic Foundation has long since been a friend of our parish, and we continue to receive significant financial support from that charitable organization. I am excited about these new light fixtures because they will reduce our carbon footprint and our monthly electric bill. In this way, we will become better stewards of the resources God has given us.
