From the Pastor's Desk

We were happy to receive Michael Stinziano and Elizabeth Brown last Sunday after our 12:30 p.m. Mass. These are two city councilmembers who came to Christ the King to listen to stories of parishioners who would benefit from a citywide municipal I.D. This listening session was hosted in part by the BREAD Organization, which has been working with a variety of stakeholders in order to pave the way for a municipal I.D. in Columbus. Several members of our church family shared how their quality of life would improve significantly if such an I.D. were available to them and their loved ones. I was grateful that we had an audience with city officials who are interested in moving forward with this project. Let us pray that a municipal I.D. be introduced in Columbus soon, as it has in numerous other cities throughout the U.S. already.

This Sunday is the anniversary of *Roe v. Wade*, the Supreme Court decision that made abortion legal in our country. The Church has designated Monday, January 23, as a day of prayer for the legal guarantee of the right to life. It is also a day of penance for the tragic sin of abortion in our land. Please consider extra prayer and fasting on Monday to give spiritual support to the Church's efforts to build a culture of life in the U.S. Please also consider joining Bishop Campbell for the annual Respect Life Mass on Monday at 10:30 a.m. at the cathedral. It will conclude in time for the noontime Roe Remembrance at the Ohio Statehouse. (This year the event will be inside the Statehouse Atrium, so thankfully we will not have to worry about the weather.) Let us stand in solidarity as we defend the dignity and sanctity of all human life.
