From the Pastor's Desk

This week, I would like to discuss Mass intentions here at Christ the King. It is our practice as Catholics to ask for Masses to be celebrated for loved ones, both living and deceased. Many of our parishioners ask that a Mass be celebrated for loved ones on their birthday or on the anniversary of their death. (You can see the Mass intentions printed in the bulletin each week.) This is a beautiful act of charity, and I encourage it highly. However, due to the high number of requests for Mass intentions, I have decided to put into place a few policies that will help us stay organized in the parish office. I am asking that parishioners come to the parish to coordinate Mass intentions with a parish secretary during office hours. This means that we can no longer receive Mass intentions over the phone, and only those confined to their home should make requests by mail. Also, in order to give an opportunity to all parishioners, the Mass intention book will open on the first business day of September for scheduling Mass intentions the following year. We want to allow as many parishioners as possible to offer Masses for loved ones, so only six Mass intentions per parishioner will be scheduled on the initial day the Mass Intention book opens. Our previous policies will continue: parishioners can only schedule one Mass intention for a particular loved one each month, and the \$10 donation that accompanies a Mass intention must be received the day the request is made. I thank you in advance for your cooperation in these matters as we pray for our family members and friends.
