Report on Past Activities:

At the BREAD Annual Assembly, BREAD leaders vote to tackle mental health! Research on this problem started on December 9, 2013.

Last Saturday, January 25th, the Christ the King team members had a meeting. There were 7 (of ten) people. They had an update on bread's work as follows:

Mental Health. The Mental Health committee is in the process of focusing in on a specific injustice. They have met with Rachelle Martin of NAMI Franklin County, Laura Moskow-Sigal of Mental Health America of Franklin County, Mary Brennen-Hoffman of North Central Mental Health Services, Debbie Nixon-Hughes of the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addictions, Michelle Perry of Netcare Access, David Royer and Dr. Kevin Dixon from the ADAMH Board, and Jack Cameron of the Ohio Empowerment Coalition. Every person they have met with has identified certain gaps in the Mental Health system, including a lack of stable housing, low numbers of psychiatric beds, and lack of communication between service providers. We have also heard repeatedly that people with severe and persistent mental illness die, on average, 27 years earlier than someone in the general population from a condition unrelated to their mental illness.

Discrimination against immigrants. Bread is on the early stages of planning a large community event that will take place on March 27th at 1:00 p.m. at Christ the King Catholic Church. This event will bring together the Mexican Consulate, law enforcement, stakeholders, and law enforcement officials from outside the city who have succeeded in making their communities more welcoming.

Restorative Justice. The three new sites will be in North and South Linden, Near East Side, and Westerville. These circles are projected to divert one hundred low-risk, non-violent youth out of the court system this year! These circles are in need of volunteers. For information, please call at 614-525-3130. The next training will take place on March 22nd.

Education. Our committee has met twice with the interim superintendent, Dr. Good, and delivered a powerful message to our school board that our children need to be in school learning, and the KEY Truancy program is successfully making that happen. Finally, the school district officially adopted a policy that out of school suspensions will no longer be used as a response to truancy.

Report of Future Activities:

In order to support bread' efforts Christ the King Parish is going to promote the participation of its parishioners. On the weekend of **Febrary 22-23** Father Schalk is going to preach about justice and how this parish can be involved in bread's justice ministry. Also, there will be tables in the vestibule, and donuts (bread) will be given to the people at the end of all masses.

Report on Activities:

- Leak in the crying room was the result of a previous weld that became rusted out. It has been repaired and we are waiting for a company to come in and wrap the pipe with insulation. The carpet was ruined and will be replaced. We are looking at new chairs to replace the ones in the room.
- The outside basement doors at the school do not fit properly and as a result the kitchen is very cold. I have contacted a company that sells and installs these doors for a quote. I will be seeking quotes from two other companies.
- The glass panel in the door that is by the office has been replaced by Franklin Art Glass. When the weather warms up a little we have them back to look at some of the other cracks in the stained glass.
- The phone for the Sisters is now working
- The plumber came today to fix the downstairs toilet, the trap in the sacristy under the sink and the trap and water shut off valve that was leaking.
- The heater in the west side vestibule that is nearest the Bethesda building is not working and leaked. We have a quote from Farber to get it fixed but we are waiting for a Catholic Mutual to review a claim we put in since the heater sprang the leak as a result of the cold weather.
- On Friday there will be a meeting with the principal of the school and maintenance people and Fr. Schalk, Suzanne and myself looking at possibly changing vendors with the boilers. The steam traps have been replaced by Farber our present vendor and as a result the heat has been better throughout the school and the boiler is running a lot better according to Jeff. We will be evaluating the situation to see if a change is necessary as we discuss this with a new boiler company and a new chemical company. The reason we are looking at a change is that the school has had so many problems that the principal feels that maybe a new company can help solve the issues.
