Report on Past Activities:

Monthly meetings for youth & adult participants in the Appalachian Project have focused on learning about power tools and building community. There are 50 youth registered to participate in the June work week in Scioto County.

Light blue T-shirts have arrived and will be given out at the June meeting. Mission crosses will be distributed following the Mass on the Day of Departure.

There are ten work sites ranging from building a new home on a trailer frame (continued from last year) to splitting logs for firewood and painting the tin roof on a historic one room school house. There are plumbing issues and light construction. One elderly couple has no indoor plumbing—no running water & they utilize an outhouse. One man runs a small one-man Mission with a food pantry & clothing store and needs help because his former facility burned to the ground & he had no insurance.

Shares of stock will be sold at St. Catharine's the weekend of 5/31 & 6/1. A food drive will be held at St. Catharine's the same weekend.

The English and Spanish-speaking Youth Groups continue to meet with Fr. Schalk and Saul Buitron. There are activities and games.

Report on Activities:

1. We are looking to replace the boiler sometime in the future. The quote I received from Farber, who works on our heating and air conditioning system, is \$122,640. This includes the removing the old boiler and some piping.
2. The cost to repair the bells outside is \$20,000. We will be looking at doing this sometime in the summer
3. Altman has been contacted to remove the wood from the fountain.
4. Schilling roofing came out to fix the leak that has been a problem by the back alter. The problem seems to be stemming from the upper roof where the drain pipes are located that are hidden in the walls on the outside of the church that drain on the flat roof. The drains on the upper roof are clogged with the rubber roof that was placed on the upper and lower roof. As a result, the drains are not draining and could be causing the snow melt system to not work properly. Schilling is to give me a quote on how much it would cost to cut away the portion that is clogging the drains.
5. Lift is done and paid for and is available for use. The remotes and keys are in the safe, so if there is an event, these two items need to be sign out by a representative of the event and returned at the end of the event.
6. The building bridges event, the integrating of Hispanic families with Anglo families will be on the 29th of June. This will be a pot luck event getting families to know each other and to share cultural backgrounds, similarities and differences with each other.
7. 231 individuals and families got their picture taken for the parish directory. A committee is working to put together the art work and narrative about the events of the parish.
