### **Report on Past Activities:**

#### **Charismatic group:**

Regular prayer meeting on Saturdays at 7:00pm in the basement of the parish.  
The group led a Christmas posada the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of December, and presented a Pastorela (Christmas Play) during its prayer meeting the last Saturday of December. Special activities and gifts for children were provided.

#### **Liturgy & Communion Ministry:**

Regular weekly services. Some of the ministers led one of the Guadalupe novena nights at the temple, and others participated in the Pastorela play on December 21, along with members of other parish ministries. This ministry was actively involved in the celebration of the Christmas "posadas".

#### **Spanish choirs:**

Regular weekly services. The choir joined the English choir on December the 8<sup>th</sup> for the Immaculate Conception Solemn Mass. The Spanish choir led as well one of the novena nights in honor to the Virgin of Guadalupe, and sang the mañanitas and special Mass for this festivity on December 12, 2014. The ministry also led on of the Christmas posada nights and some of its members participated at the Pastorela on December 21.

#### **Hospitality group:**

Regular meetings every other week to enrich their faith and coordinate service at Masses. The hospitality group worked together with the Spanish charismatic group during the Posada and Pastorela nights, led by the prayer ministry.

#### **Catechesis:**

PSR and RCIA classes stopped on December 7, 2014 due to Christmas break. Teachers actively participated at the Guadalupe novena, Christmas posadas and Pastorela.

#### **Missionaries of the Word Sister:**

The sisters continued providing Bible Studies on Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays & Fridays at 5:30 p.m.; Saturdays at 4:00pm. They conducted follow up meetings with the missionaries of the word, Mondays and Thursdays at the Convent. The sisters started, along with Father Schalk and Saul, the marriage preparation for those couples participating at the Community Weddings on May 30, 2015. The sisters continue conducting weekly meetings with the CERS to reflect in depth on their missionary work. They, as well, conducted the pre-baptismal classes each month. The sisters worked in collaboration with Saul Buitron to coordinate the Guadalupe novena and Christmas posadas. They, as well, prepared and presented a Christmas play in English which was shown to both, English and Spanish communities of the parish. Another sister joined the community in December, Sister Jacqueline Garcia who hit the ground running being involved in the Christmas activities very well. The sisters coordinated couple of visits to the Southeastern Correctional Institute in Lancaster. This was in collaboration with St. Stephen Church.
