From the Pastor's Desk

I found a great idea for Lent in a pamphlet from Our Sunday Visitor. It's called the "1-1-1 Plan": one sin, one add-in, one give-up. It's a simple way for us to live Lent. Step one: focus on eliminating one sin or fault that is getting in the way of your relationship with God. It could be one of the seven deadly sins or one of the Ten Commandments. It could be something major or minor. Whatever it is, do your best to change your habits and ask God for the grace to overcome that particular sin. Step two: add one positive activity that will deepen your life of prayer or service. The opportunities are endless. For example, you could spend an hour with the Lord in the church on Fridays, visit an infirmed neighbor each week, or attend the Catholic Women's or Men's Conference. These sorts of things expand your heart and help you to know, love, and serve God a little bit better. Step three: deny yourself something that you like. Most of us are familiar with this step, making a sacrifice of sweets, Facebook, or fast food for forty days. The key to this step is choosing something that is difficult yet doable. It should hurt – but it shouldn't kill you! I like the "1-1-1 Plan" because it isn't one-dimensional. It gives us an opportunity to grow in a variety of ways. I hope the "1-1-1 Plan" will be helpful to you.
