From the Pastor's Desk

I hope you still have chocolate bunnies left, because we are still celebrating Easter. It's an entire season, not just a day. And our celebration continues this weekend with Divine Mercy Sunday, a feast on which we give thanks for the unfathomable, infinite mercy of Christ. God's primary attribute is his mercifulness, and we believe Jesus is Divine Mercy incarnate. His greatest desire is to forgive us, wash away our sin, mend our brokenness, and grant us peace.

Speaking of peace, I encourage you to take a few moments to ponder Jesus' first appearance to his apostles after the Resurrection. (Open your Bible to John, chapter 20. You'll find the story there.) There are a number of themes in this passage to consider: peace, purpose, forgiveness, faith. You will not regret taking ten or fifteen minutes simply to reflect on Christ's words: *peace be with you, as the Father has sent me, so I send you; receive the Holy Spirit; do not be unbelieving, but believe.* These four phrases touch upon the very essence of Christianity and have the power to bring healing to your life. Find a place of silence and allow these words to sink into your heart at some point during this week. You will find that Christ's mercy and love are richer any Easter candy.

May the Lord bless you throughout this week!
