A Message from the Appalachian Project: This week youth volunteers and adult team members from our parish will be working in Scioto County to repair homes for disadvantaged families. Please pray for a safe, productive, and spiritually blessed week for all who volunteer and for all who are served. Thank you for your support.

Over the past few years much of American society has embraced the idea of same-sex unions. Is there a way to respond to this cultural shift without being considered naive or intolerant?
