(If you can, join us for Mass that day at 7:00 a.m.) I cannot overstate the importance of Saint Joseph in our spiritual life as Catholics. He was chosen by God the Father to be the guardian of both Jesus and the Blessed Virgin Mary. We believe that Saint Joseph continues to be an effective and vigilant guardian, and for that reason he is the patron of the Universal Catholic Church. One could describe Saint Joseph as prayerful, chaste, faithful, and hard-working – attributes worthy of our imitation. I encourage everyone to develop a relationship with the foster father of Jesus and to visit the statue of Saint Joseph in our church on a regular basis. He is the one with the carpenter's tools!

Next, I wanted to make you aware that I am going to be part of the Saint Gabriel Catholic Radio Spirit Drive this week. This is their biannual effort to raise interest and funds for the station.
