I received a letter from Bishop Campbell's office regarding the Community Shelter Board (CSB). For the second year in a row, the bishop would like Catholics throughout Franklin County to consider supporting the CSB as we address the issue of homelessness in Columbus. The CSB is an organization that coordinates our city's response to the homeless population. In order to continue their important work, the CSB is asking individuals and families to become Housing Heroes during their "From Homeless to Home" campaign. Money raised during the campaign will fund programs that help men, women, and children secure safe and affordable housing.

On a personal note, I am a monthly donor to the Community Shelter Board. The fact that we have a significant population of homeless living in Columbus is, for me, truly distressing. However, instead of giving small amounts of cash to homeless men and women on the street, I prefer to give to the CSB, an organization that can effectively pave a way out of homelessness for individuals. I believe that the CSB best helps the homeless create and sustain a life that is in accord with their dignity.
