Report on Past Activities:

At the BREAD Annual Assembly, BREAD leaders vote to tackle mental health! Research on this problem started on December 9, 2013.

The BREAD team members, had their information Day on Sunday, February 23rd 2014, here at Christ the King Church. They handed out information to our parishioners, and gave donuts (bread) to the people.

BREAD UPDATE

Mental Health. The Mental Health committee is in the process of focusing in on a specific injustice. They have met with representatives from 8 mental health agencies including NAMI Franklin County, Mental Health America of Franklin County, North Central Mental Health Services, the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addictions, and the ADAMH Board. They have learned about gaps in the Mental Health system, including a lack of stable housing, low numbers of psychiatric beds, and lack of communication between service providers. Other startling statistics that they have learned are:

1. In Franklin County, 205,100 people experience a mental disorder each year. (Source: Mental Health America of Franklin County)
2. In Franklin County, 41,000 people are affected by serious mental illness, over 20,500 of them have severe and persistent mental illness (Source: Mental Health America of Franklin County).

Discrimination against immigrants. Bread will be holding a large community event that will take place on March 27th at 1 p.m. at Christ the King Catholic Church (2777 East Livingston Ave). This event will bring together the Mexican Consulate, law enforcement, stakeholders, and law enforcement officials from outside the city who have succeeded in making their communities more welcoming. Join us!

Restorative Justice. The three new sites will be in North and South Linden, Near East Side, and Westerville. These circles are projected to divert one hundred low-risk, non-violent youth out of the court system this year! This circles are in need of volunteers. For information, please call at 614-525-3130. The next training will take place on March 22nd.

Education. Our committee has met twice with the interim superintendent, Dr. Good, and delivered a powerful message to our school board that our children need to be in school learning, and the KEY Truancy program is successfully making that happen. Finally, the school district officially adopted a policy that out of school suspensions will no longer be used as a response to truancy.

- We are also looking at a company that will service our boilers only since that is their expertise. We will keep Farber who are mechanical contractors, who are good at piping and air conditioning.
