Pastor's Report

Sisters have arrived. Many plans are in development for their tenure here. Currently are taking classes at Columbus State Community College. In February they will conduct 15 days of mission. They will train parishioners to go out into the community. This will be used as a way to announce the additional Saturday Spanish Mass at Christ the King. They have been a presence at various church events.

Chris Drake is experiencing additional health issues. Pray for his recovery. In short term there is help with church cleaning using volunteers. Spring Fest will be dedicated to him for his years of service to the parish.

Evangelization through the media seminar – some of the ideas from this seminar are in the works. By July 1 the website will be enhanced. Facebook page and twitter account. Present Christ the King through the media.

Youth group update—going well. Will try to bring the two groups together. Between 6-10 youth at each event.

Spring Fest – April 26 – different event than the Cinco event at St. Stephen's which is cosponsored by Christ the King. The funds raised this year are for the Sisters and their programs. \$80 a plate for the Cinco event. Dates have been announced in the bulletin.

BREAD – May 12 event with the Nehemiah Action. Want a more sustained function for BREAD. Make BREAD issues a year round concern. March 27 at 1pm Christ the King is hosting the "Welcome Columbus" event. Address local law enforcement – Dayton Chief of Police and possible Columbus Chief of Police. Consulate from Indianapolis. Matricula ID that is recognized as Mexican ID card for illegals. Following from the BREAD Facebook page on this event -- *This will be an opportunity to learn about a photo identification card issued by the Mexican Consulate, the Matricula Consular, and to hear what other cities have done to build positive relationships between law enforcement and immigrant communities.*

Lift will be installed in the next few weeks for the stairs by the Vincentian room. Take a week or so to install.

Servant of Christ the King plaque will be moved from the office to the vestibule of church. Need additional discussion concerning use of the vestibule space. Possibly move the statues to put the bulletin boards there. One in English and one in Spanish. Steve McIntyre will put the plaque in the vestibule with fasteners that will not harm to marble walls.
