- Fundraising- report submitted. Fiesta de Mayo was a success. Money will be calculated soon.
- Garden Club—will need to determine the status of the fountain. Determine the involvement of the Altman family since there have been changes in the process of how the fixes have been paid. There is the need now for a contract with the Altman's detailing what will be provided and how it will be covered. Pete would be involved in the discussions. Garden funding pays for cleaning the nozzles and shock for the water. The rest of the maintenance needs to be covered by a knowledgeable worker. There would be an alternative if the fountain is not going to be filled with water. Quality Pools has done the servicing in the past. Still need to have volunteers to assist with the garden.
- Appalachia Project --Father will visit on Tuesday June 27, 2017. Car washes will be done in June.
